For the academic year 2008/09, the University of Granada and the University of Santiago de Compostela, together with the Euroarab Foundation for Higher Studies and the Institute of Peace and Conflict Studies, will launch the 6th Edition of the Interuniversity Master in International Cooperation and NGO Management, in collaboration with the Spanish Agency for International Cooperation and the Andalusian Agency for International Cooperation.

In spite of the greater institutional presence of international cooperation and NGOs within the globalisation context, there is a lack in experts with an integral knowledge in international politics and management of international cooperation and NGOs. Thus, the aim of the Master is to provide specialised training and expertise in these fields with a multidisciplinary perspective and the utmost academic rigour.

Once the 500 teaching hours of the Master have been completed, students will need to sit a final test. The best 11 graduates will be selected for carrying out a paid internship in which they will take part in the management of cooperation projects launched by the Andalusian Agency for International Cooperation in Mediterranean countries, Latin America and Subsaharian Africa.
